Annual Dinner and Dance

Again this year, the Canadian Society of Cinematographers is presenting craft awards recognizing the artistic achievements of Society members.

Awards will be presented for Cinematography in the following three categories: *Features*, *Documentary*, *Television Commercials*.

Films and television commercials must have been produced and completed between October 1, 1975 and September 30, 1976.

The Canadian Film Editors Guild is also presenting its own Effigy Awards for excellence in film editing in the following categories: *Features*, *T.V. Drama*, *Sales and Promotion (over 3 minutes)*, *Sales and Promotion (under 3 minutes)*, *Documentary and Educational (over 20 minutes)*, *Documentary and Educational (under 20 minutes)*, and *Short Subject*. All films entered in the above categories are also eligible for the *Sound Editing Award*.

Presentation of the Awards will be made at the Annual Dinner & Dance of the Canadian Film Editors Guild and the Canadian Society of Cinematographers to be held on the evening of Saturday, November 13 at Ontario Place. A new award, dubbed "The Golden Reel", will be presented by the Canadian Motion Picture Distributors Association at the Canadian Film Awards on October 24th.

The Golden Reel Award will honor the producer of the Canadian feature film that has achieved the highest level of commercial acceptance, in Canadian and foreign markets, during the last year.

Millard Roth, Executive Director of the CMPDA, announced the creation

of the Golden Reel. The Award will be presented annually and is designed to achieve the following objectives:

- To emphasize the importance of commercial endeavour and achievement.
- To reinforce the need for foreign distribution of Canadian films.
- To recognize marketing and exploitation efforts.
- To begin to establish meaningful identification and reinforcement for these efforts and accomplishments.

The presentation will be made by Vic Beattie, the President of the Association, at the annual Canadian Film Awards which will be telecast across Canada by the CTV Television Network on October 24th, 1976.
